This is in response to your December 9, 2008, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for all documents related to the USDA license permit application submitted by Lex Salisbury and/or Stephen Wehrmann. Agency employees conducted a thorough search of their files and enclosed are two pages consisting of an application for license and inspection report that are responsive to your request. However, information is being withheld under FOIA Exemption 6, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). This exemption protects information from disclosure when its release would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

Additionally, information is being withheld under FOIA Exemption 7(C), 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(7)(C). This exemption protects from disclosure records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, the release of which could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

This office has been informed that reports, complaints, correspondence, memorandums, meeting notes and minutes, drafts, notes and summaries of conversations and interviews, emails, and any other forms of written or recorded communication, including internal agency staff memorandums, information regarding applicant's relationship to the Lowery Park Zoo in Tampa, Florida, or records of acquisition and disposition were located.

You may appeal our partial denial and/or no records determination. If you choose to appeal, your appeal must be in writing and must be received at the following address within 45 days of the date of this letter:
