(2) Primary enclosures must be constructed and maintained so that they: (ix) Enable all surfaces in contact with nonhuman primates to be readily cleaned and sanitized in accordance with §3.84(b)(3) of this subpart, or replaced when worn or soiled.

***The concrete walls of the primate house (housing the colobus and howler monkeys) have multiple areas of peeling paint throughout each enclosure. The walls, in their present condition, cannot be readily cleaned and sanitized. In addition, paint chips, if inhaled by the primates could cause harm to the animals. Correct by: January 28, 2006.
