HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.**

(a) Structure: construction. Housing facilities for nonhuman primates must be designed and constructed so that they are structurally sound for the species of nonhuman primates housed in them. They must be kept in good repair, and they must protect the animals from injury, contain the animals securely, and restrict other animals from entering.

\*\*\*In the Colobus monkey enclosure, there is one door that is made of wood, the wood is deteriorating, and that surface can't be readily cleaned or sanitized

(xi) Provide sufficient space for the nonhuman primates to make normal postural adjustments with freedom of movement.

\*\*\*In the Howler monkey enclosure, there is a barrel that is hung from the ceiling; the barrel is hung too close to the ceiling and thus not allowing the monkeys to have normal posture while sitting on the barrel.

**3.125 ( a )  
FACILITIES, GENERAL.**

(a) Structural strength. The facility must be constructed of such material and of such strength as appropriate for the animals involved. The indoor and outdoor housing facilities shall be structurally sound and shall be maintained in good repair to protect the animals from injury and to contain the animals.

\*\*\*One door in the rhino enclosure is tilted, the tracks for the door are banded, and there is a possibility that the door may come off track at one time. Need to repair the door to assure that the door stays in place.  
Another door in the rhino enclosure is rusted and has a sharp edge that is banded, and that could cause injury to the animal.
